Optical Illusions - Lesson 7



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Some people say Jesus was just a good man and a good teacher. A careful reading of the Bible tells us that's not possible. He was either a liar, a lunatic, or the Messiah. The testimony of the gospel writers says He was the Son of God.

Matthew 17:1-13



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

What happened when Peter, James, and John went with Jesus up the mountain?

(The transfiguration, Moses and Elijah appeared, God spoke.)

What did God tell the disciples? (That Jesus was His Son and to listen to Him.)

Was Jesus just a good man? (No.)



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

Would it have been okay if Jesus had been just a good teacher?

How is Jesus different than other religious leaders? (He claimed to be the Son of God.)

Why is it important to know Who Jesus really is?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this series' second memory verse, Hebrews 11:1. Remind them that the book of Hebrews is all about Who Jesus is and what He did, and that we can trust Him to be our Savior, to watch over us, and to come back someday to rule the world and take care of everything.
